The Evangelical Lutheran Church in Tanzania (ELCT) is a faith-based organization registered on 19th June 1963 with headquarters offices at Arusha. The mission of the ELCT is to provide holistic care to all people. The management and leadership oversight is provided by the ELCT Secretary General assisted by four Deputy Secretary Generals (DSG) - including the DSG for Mission and Evangelism, DSG for Social Services and Women's Works, DSG for Planning and Development and DSG for Finance and Administration.

ELCT wishes to recruit qualified, motivated and dynamic individual for the below described position. All applicants are strongly advised to read to adhere to application instructions and guidance provided.

Position: DEPUTY SECRETARY GENERAL – MISSION AND EVANGELISM (1)

Reports to: Secretary General, ELCT

Duty Station: ELCT Headquarters (Currently in Arusha) with frequent travels around Tanzania and outside the country.

Tenure: 5 years contract, renewable once upon performance satisfaction

Position Summary

The Deputy Secretary General – Mission and Evangelism will plan, coordinate and manage all the functions of Mission and Evangelism Department namely Mission Strategy and Planning, Church Planting and Growth, Evangelism and Faith Sharing, Managing Church Literature and ensure Doctrinal compliances, Collaboration and Networking with local and international mission partners as well as Support for Christian Education and revitalization of existing congregations.

Routine and General responsibilities

1. Leadership and Oversight

Provide overall leadership and supervision for all activities related to Missions and Evangelism within the Church.

- 2. Strategic Planning and Coordination Plan, coordinate, guide, and monitor the Church's efforts to faithfully proclaim the Gospel to all people—both within Tanzania and internationally.
- 3. Integration of Pastoral Programs Align and monitor the Church's pastoral initiatives, with a focus on Christian education, advocacy, youth engagement, and scripture dissemination.

4. Curriculum Development

Participate in the development and evaluation of theological and Christian education curricula for Church institutions and training centres.

5. Mission Expansion

Coordinate the establishment and support of mission areas aimed at advancing the Lutheran faith both nationally and globally.

- 6. **Mission Support Centers and Communication** Oversee the operations of mission-related centers and initiatives that promote evangelism, spiritual growth, and effective communication.
- 7. **Spiritual Leadership at ELCT Headquarters** Serve as the Chaplain at the Church's national headquarters and facilitate spiritual refreshment programs for staff and ministers based there.

8. Bishops' Conference and retreat Coordination

Act as the primary coordinator for the Conference of Bishops, ensuring smooth planning, communication, and execution of joint activities.

9. Reporting and Accountability

Report directly to the Secretary General of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Tanzania (ELCT) and ensure alignment with the Church's overall mission and vision.

10. All ELCT Pastors Conference

Plan and coordinate all ELCT pastors every four years and ensure the outcome are shared with all dioceses.

Qualifications, Experience and Skills Required:

- 1. He/she must be a Pastor from the Evangelical Lutheran Church in Tanzania
- 2. Must portray exemplary conducts, live and serve in a way that reflects the values and expectations of ELCT.
- 3. Holder of a Bachelor degree in Divinity/Theology
- 4. Master's degree will be an added advantage.
- 5. 5+ years of progressive leadership experience in Mission and Evangelism related activities.
- 6. Experience managing and overseeing programs related to Church growth
- 7. Strong interpersonal skills to work effectively with diverse teams, stakeholders, and communities.
- 8. Strong leadership and management skills; excellent communication and interpersonal abilities; knowledge of the Church.
- 9. Commitment to the mission and values of ELCT; ability to work collaboratively with diverse groups; strong analytical and problem-solving skills.
- 10. Member of the ELCT and committed to the ELCT vision and mission.
- 11. The applicant's age should range from 40 to 55 years with sound mind & good health
- 12. Should be computer literate and competent in use of Microsoft software applications.
